- (a) the number of working women's hostel in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the details of total capacity and total occupancy in these hostels, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government is taking steps to promote working women's hostel;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government plans to increase the number of such hostels in the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a)to(f) State/UT-wise details of functional Sakhi Niwas (Working Women Hostel) along with capacity and number of residents are placed at **Annexure-I.**

The Sakhi Niwas Scheme (Working Women Hostel) under the overaching Misson Shakti, is a demand driven centrally sponsored scheme where States/UTs assess their requirement as per local needs and proposals are approved by the Programme Approval Board (PAB) after discussion with State/UTs. The scheme aims to promote availiablity of safe and conveniently located accommodations for working women, with Day care facility for the children in urban, semi-urban and even rural areas where employment opportunity for women exist.
