HEALTH PROJECT IN KALIMPONG AND NORTH DINAJPUR DISTRICTS

1087. SHRI RAJU BISTA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the projects undertaken under National Health Mission during FY 2022-23 and PM-ABHIM along with the 15th Finance Commission Health Grants for Darjeeling (GTA+SPM), Kalimpong, and North Dinajpur districts;
- (b) the details of the infrastructure developed and facilities created through such funds; and
- (c) the quantum of the funds sanctioned along with the details of its current utilization ?

- (a) to (c): Under National Health Mission, a total of Rs 4707.81 crore has been approved for FY 2022-23 for the State of West Bengal. The details are available at Uniform Resource Locator (URL) as under:

Under Fifteenth Finance Commission (FC-XV), a total of Rs 829.20 crores has been approved during FY 2022-23 for the State of West Bengal. A total of 22 Block Public Health Units (BPHU) have been sanctioned for the State of West Bengal in 2022-23 of which 4 BPHUs are in Darjeeling and Uttar Dinajpur each and 2 BPHUs are in Kalimpong. A total of 121 Building less Sub Centres and 5 Primary Health Centres have been sanctioned for the FY 2022-23 of which 3 Sub-centers are in Darjeeling , 6 in

Uttar Dinajpur and 1 in Kalimpong. A total of 384 Urban Health And Wellness Centres(UHWCs) have been sanctioned for FY 2022-23 of which 21 UHWCs are in Darjeeling, 14 in Uttar Dinajpur and 1 in Kalimpong.

Under Pradhan Mantri- Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM), A total of Rs 150.19 crores has been approved for FY 2022-23 for the State of West Bengal. A total of 5 Integrated Public Health Labs (IPHL) and 5 Critical Care Blocks (CCB) have been sanctioned of which 1 CCB is in Darjeeling.
