**KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA IN BSF CAMP IN BIRPUR**

**†1245. SHRI DILESHWAR KAMAIT:**

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the time by when a Kendriya Vidyalaya will be established in BSF camp situated in Birpur in Supaul parliamentary constituency which is a very backward and flood prone border area of Bihar;
- (b) the reasons for not establishing the same by registering the land so far;
- (c) whether the land registration fee would be paid from the Para-military Forces Welfare Fund;
- (d) whether the Government has any other scheme for establishment of said Kendriya Vidyalaya; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (e) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per norms. The proposals for establishment of new KVs are subject to approval of the competent authority as per extant procedures. At present, 1252 KVs including 49 KVs in the State of Bihar are functioning across the country.

Ministry of Home Affairs has informed that BSF does not have any camp in Birpur in Supaul Parliamentary Constituency. As such, there is no proposal in BSF for establishing KV in Birpur.
