Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has laid the foundation stone of Employees' State Insurance Corporation hospital at village Pana Buzurg under Shahjahanpur Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh on 24.12.2021 and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the time-frame and expenditure likely to be incurred on construction of this hospital; and**
- (c) whether the construction work is going on as per time schedule and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor along with the accountable officers/persons?**

(a) to (c): Government has laid the foundation stone on 24.12.2021 at Village Pana Buzurg, Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh for the construction of a 30 bedded (upgradable to 100 beds) hospital. Construction work has been assigned to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) at an estimate amount of Rs. 92.48 Crore. The construction work will be commenced after conversion of land use by the State Government.
