Assessment of Vidyanjali Schemes

1312. SHRIMATI SAJDA AHMED:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted an assessment of the potential positive impact of the Vidyanjali schemes;
- (b) if so, the details of the findings and outcomes;
- (c) whether there is any proposal from the Government to revamp the scheme, specifically towards the inclusion of unaided private schools in it;
- (d) whether the Government has any plan to introduce incentives or rewards to volunteers or organizations who are actively participating in the scheme; and
- (e) the details on the number of schools registered under the Vidyanjali 2.0 scheme across the country and the distribution of these registrations, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Vidyanjali-the school volunteer initiative was launched in September 2021. Regular interactive sessions in physical and virtual mode are held with States/UTs to assess the performance of onboarding of government and government-aided schools on the Vidyanjali portal as well as on mobilisation of volunteers. Schools report the number of children benefitted on the portal after completion of the volunteer activity. As of December 6, 2023, around 60.61 lakh children have got benefited with volunteer support under Vidyanjali.

- (c) Based on the feedback received from the stakeholders, the portal is constantly improved upon to make it more user friendly. Private Schools are allowed to participate in Vidyanjali as a mentor by mentoring nearby government and government aided schools. A separate module for CSR contributors has also been developed.
- (d) A digital certificate is provided to the volunteers upon successful completion of each activity under Vidyanjali. Volunteers can download this e-certificate from their dashboard on the Vidyanjali portal. Further, a new feature of E-badges of different colours has been designed based on the number of completed volunteer activities on the portal and included in the revamped portal.
- (e) As on 6th December, 2023, there are total 6,77,856 government and government aided schools registered on the Vidyanjali portal. The State-wise status of registered schools is at Annexure-I.
