- (a) The exhibition titled, "Re(ad)dress: Return of Treasures" was held from 22 to 28 Feb. 2023 at the Convention Centre, Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh amidst the backdrop of Culture Working Group meeting of G20.
 - Representative sculptures, paintings and scrolls, etc. highlighting the value of diverse cultural heritage returned from various countries were displayed in the exhibition.
- (b) 115 numbers of antiquities have returned to India in 2023.
- (c) 344 antiquities have returned to India since 2014. One antiquity had returned to India during 2004-13.
