**KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN KERALA**

**1372. SHRI HIBI EDEN:**

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the lack of basic amenities, vacant positions for teachers and non-teaching staff, and insufficient infrastructure in Kendriya Vidyalayas as in K V NAD Aluva, K V Ernakulam, K V No. 1 Kochi, K V No. 2 Kochi, K V Port Trust Kochi, K V INS Dronacharya, under the Ernakulam Cluster;
- (b) whether the Government can provide information on the funds allocated or likely to be allocated, Vidyalaya-wise, for Kendriya Vidyalayas in Ernakulam District, Kerala, for the financial years 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the data and statistics for the last five financial years?

(a) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) NAD Aluva, KV Ernakulam, KV No.1 Kochi, KV No. 2 Kochi, KV Port Trust Kochi and KV INS Dronacharya in KVS Ernakulam Region have basic amenities such as permanent school building, toilets, drinking water facilities, labs and playgrounds in accordance with KVS norms. 1936 number of teaching and non-teaching staff are in position in KVs under KVS Ernakulam Region, including KV NAD Aluva, KV Ernakulam, KV No.1 Kochi, KV No.2 Kochi, KV Port Trust Kochi and KV INS Dronacharya.

The vacancies arise due to retirement, resignation, promotion and additional requirement on account of up-gradation / sanctioning of new streams as well as enhancement of students' strength. Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and efforts are made to fill up the vacancies as per the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules. Teachers are also engaged on contractual basis for temporary duration by KVS to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered.

(b) & (c) The budgetary support is provided every year as Grants-in-aid to KVS on a consolidated basis and not State / UT / Vidyalaya-wise. The budgetary support is made to KVS under three distinct Heads of Account viz. Salaries, General and Creation of Capital Assets for opening and functioning of KVs. The funds released/allocated to KVS during the last five financial years 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, and current year 2023-24 are as under: -
