Digitization of Land Records

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has covered the digitization of land records in all the districts of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (b) if so, the details and the percentage of land covered under the Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP), district-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor, and
- (d) whether any measures being taken to ensure the successful execution of DILRMP in the region and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c) As on 07.12.2023, as per Management Information System (MIS) of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP), Records of Rights (RoR) of 96.38% of villages in various districts of the Union Territory (UT) of Jammu & Kashmir have been computerised. A statement indicating district-wise status of computerization of RoRs in UT of Jammu & Kashmir is annexed.

(d) The Department of Land Resources is providing 100% financial and technical support to all States/UTs, including UT of Jammu and Kashmir, for implementation of DILRMP. The progress under various components of DILRMP is monitored regularly through the Central Management Information System (MIS) of DILRMP, Review Meetings, both physical and through Video Conference, Workshops and field visits by senior officers to the States/UTs to impress upon the States/UTs for expediting the programme implementation. Further, Department has also initiated Bhoomi Samvaad series of dialogues, consultations, deliberation to expedite progress in implementation of DILRMP and continuous updation of MIS portal by States/UTs under DILRMP.
