- (b) the quantum of pulses and edible oils imported during the last three years;
- (c) the applicable import duty on pulses and edible oils during the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) the names of the major countries from which the pulses and edible oils were imported and the total import duty on it, year-wise?

(a) The average production of pulses and oilseeds in the country for the last five years (2017-18 to 2022-23) is 247.85 lakh tonnes and 360.01 lakh tonnes respectively.

(b) As per Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics (DGCI&S), the quantum of pulses and vegetable oils imported during the last three years is given as under:
