RURAL HOUSING IN NAGALAND

1503. SHRI TOKHEHO YEPTHOMI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of rural housing provided to the State of Nagaland from 2020-23;
- (b) the details of amount for each housing unit; and
- (c) whether it is implemented as per the guidelines of the Ministry and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): The targets allocated, houses sanctioned and completed under the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojna - Gramin (PMAY-G) in the State of Nagaland during Financial Years 2020-21, 2021-22, and 2022-23 are as under:

(b): Under PMAY-G, beneficiaries are provided financial Assistance of Rs.1.20 lakh in plain areas and Rs.1.30 lakh in hilly States, North Eastern States including Nagaland and UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, difficult areas, and Integrated Action Plan (IAP) districts. Additional assistance of Rs.12,000/- is extended for the construction of toilets through convergence with Swachh Bharat Mission – Gramin (SBM-G), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) or other dedicated sources of funding. The PMAY-G beneficiaries are also provided support of 90/95 person days unskilled wage employment at the current rates for the construction of his / her house in convergence with MGNREGS.

(c): Yes, Sir. The State of Nagaland is implementing the Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) as per provisions of the Framework For Implementation of PMAY-G. As of 06.12.2023, a target of 49,048 houses has been assigned to the State, and out of these, 48,830 houses have been sanctioned to the beneficiaries and 9,297 houses have been completed under the PMAY-G.
