(a) whether the Government has details of the funds sanctioned/released to Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) for its eight Fisheries Research Institutes and their thirty Regional Research Centres;

(b) if so, the respective details of funds thereof since Financial Year 2019;

(c) whether the Government is aware of the booming white shrimp farming and Pisciculture particularly in the Parliamentary Constituency of Sirsa despite challenging conditions; and

(d) whether the Government plans to establish a Fisheries Research Institute in the State of Haryana and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a &b): The details of Budget Utilization in Eight Fisheries Research Institutes (including their Regional Centres) is given as **Annexure-1**.

(c): ICAR- Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE) has developed and demonstrated farming of Pacific white shrimp (*L. vannamai*) in inland saline waters the package of practice has been widely adopted in Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. So far, the technology has been extended to over 2900 acres in Haryana, over 1200 acres in Punjab, over 1000 acres in Rajasthan and over 20 acres in Uttar Pradesh (2022-23). In case of Sirsa district, the shrimp farming is adopted in about 600 acres.

(d): Established Research Centre, ICAR- Central Institute of Fisheries Education (CIFE), Rohtak is exclusively dedicated for R&D on aquaculture & shrimp farming in the north Indian states including Haryana. The Centre is catering research & development needs of the region in the field of fisheries and aquaculture.
