FAMILIES COVERED UNDER DAY-NRLM

1559. SHRI HEMANT TUKARAM GODSE: SHRIMATI DELKAR KALABEN MOHANBHAI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of families covered under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) in the country during the last four years, State/UT and district-wise, particularly in Maharashtra, Dadar and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu;
- (b) whether a number of families in various rural areas of the country which are not able to take the benefit of the said Mission;
- (c) if so, the measures being taken by the Government in this regard so that the deprived families can also get benefits of the said Mission; and
- (d) the details of the action taken by the Government in this regard, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

a): The State/UT-wise details of the rural households mobilised into Self Help Groups (SHGs) under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) during the last four years, including Maharashtra, Dadara and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, is given at Annexure I. District wise details may be seen at the DAY-NRLM portal which can be accessed through the link:

- b): DAY-NRLM mobilises rural women from poor households to bring under the SHG network. The Mission has already mobilized approximately 9.89 crore women from rural households into 89.82 Lakh SHGs as on 30 November, 2023.
- (c) & (d): Following measures are being taken so that the deprived families can also get benefits of the mission:-
- i) All rural households with at least one deprivation, as identified by the Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC-2011), form the target group of DAY-NRLM. In addition, households identified as poor through the process of Participatory Identification of the Poor (PIP) and duly validated by the Gram Sabha are also included in the SHGs.
- ii) The Mission has special focus on early inclusion of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, persons with disability, elderly, poorest of the poor and other vulnerable sections of community into SHG fold under DAY-NRLM.
- iii) The Ministry organiseda social mobilization campaign from 7th September to 30th September, 2022. During this campaign 16,25,286 rural households were mobilized into 1,29,493 SHGs. This year, "Sangathan Se Samriddhi Abhiyaan" was launched from April 18th till 15th August 2023 in order to expedite the process of social mobilization for bringing women from left out eligible rural poor households into SHGs. During the period of "Sangathan Se Samriddhi Abhiyaan", 52,08,959 households have been mobilised into 3,75,710 SHGs.
