(a) the details of funds released by the Government for modernisation of police forces during each of the last five years State and Year-wise; and

(b) the details for the Central Forces in this regard?

(SHRI NITYANAND RAI)**

(a) : Modernisation of police forces is an ongoing and continuous process.

‘Police’ and ‘Public Order’ are State subjects as per the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution. It is the responsibility of the State Governments to

develop the police infrastructure. However, the efforts of the States for equipping and modernizing of their police forces have been supplemented

under the scheme of “Assistance to States & UTs for Modernization of Police (ASUMP)” [erstwhile scheme of Modernization of State Police

Forces (MPF)]. The budgetary allocations and releases to the State/UT

Governments under the ASUMP scheme [erstwhile scheme of

Modernization of State Police Forces(MPF)], during the last 5 years is at

Annexure-I.

(b) : Modernization of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) & Assam Rifles (AR) is also a continuous process. CAPFs & AR have been allotted sufficient funds under General Provisioning and Modernization budget heads to maintain and upgrade their inventories as per their operational requirement. The details of funds allotted to CAPFs (BSF, CISF, CRPF, ITBP, NSG & SSB) and Assam Rifles (AR) in the last five years under General Provisioning and Modernization budget heads is at Annexure-II.
