SKILL HUBS IN MAHARASHTRA

- (a) the State-wise details of skill hubs in the country;
- (b) whether it is true that a large number of people are migrating for employment;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up more skill development hubs in those States where migration rate is higher including Maharashtra;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of the schemes for skill development in such skill development hubs in Maharashtra;
- (f) the initiatives being taken by the Government for basic infrastructure and necessary assistance;
- (g) the details of the funds allocated for this purpose State-wise, including Maharashtra; and
- (h) the time by which said skill development hubs are likely to be set up and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) Under the Govt. of India, Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) provides skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling all young Indians through a comprehensive network of Centres/Institutes across the country under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Scheme of Support to Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

For integration and mainstreaming of vocational education with general education as envisaged under the National Education Policy, 2020 (NEP, 2020), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) has set up Skill Hubs in the educational institutions. The Skill Hubs are being setup in Government and Private Schools, Colleges, Universities (including Skill Universities) and other Higher Education Institutions with an aim to utilize the permanent infrastructure and other resources available at these educational institutions. The State-wise details of Skill Hubs set up under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 4.0 (PMKVY 4.0) in the country, including in the State of Maharashtra, are given at *Annexure*.

(b) As per the Report Migration in India, 2020-21, based on the PLFS 2020-21, released by Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), the total migration rate in India was

28.9%. Out of total migrant persons, around 10.8% persons migrated due to employment related reasons.

(c) to (h) Setting up of Skill Hubs is an ongoing and continuous process. Skill Hubs are set up to cater to the local demand for skilling of the region as per District Skill Development Plans. Under PMKVY, as on 31.10.2023, 122 Skill Hubs have been established in the State of Maharashtra. As Skill Hubs are set up in the available infrastructure of the educational institutions, no separate fund has been allocated for the establishment of the Skill Hubs under PMKVY. Only the cost of skill training is being reimbursed to these Skill Hubs as per the extant provisions of the scheme guidelines.
