(a) & (b) The Ministry of Panchayati Rai (MoPR) is implementing Revamped Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) w.e.f. financial year 2022-23 with the main objective for capacitating Panchayati Raj institutions (PRIs) through imparting training to all the Elected Representatives (ERs) and other stakeholders to develop their governance capabilities for leadership roles to enable the Gram Panchayats to function effectively and to deliver on Sustainable Development Goals through Localization at grassroot level.

The broad activities such as training needs assessment, development of training modules, development of training material including written material, training films and other forms of material, training of master trainers, face-to-face training courses for ERs and Panchayat functionaries, satellite based training for ERs and functionaries, exposure visit inside/ outside the States etc is being supported to States/ UTs including State of Rajasthan to improve the Capacity Building & Training under the scheme. Further, Training Management Portal has also been put in place for capturing training progress of States/ UTs including Rajasthan. As per the information available on TMP, 4726 participants trained in Rajasthan at different level during 2023-24 is at **Annexure.**
