(a) to (e): Govt. of Kerala, Food and Civil Supplies (C) Department made a request in November, 2023 to issue necessary directions for converting the excess stock of Custom Milled Rice (CMR) to Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) [erstwhile Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDMS)].

Since Department of School Education & Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education is the administrative Department for PM POSHAN (erstwhile Mid Day Meal Scheme), Government of Kerala was advised to take up with Department of School Education and Literacy Government of India. Now Government of Kerala has informed that Food & Civil Supplies Department, Kerala has taken further necessary action in the matter with the Education Department, Government of Kerala.
