#### **UNMANNED LEVEL CROSSINGS**

### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of deaths reported at the unmanned level crossings, State-wise and the kind of assistance provided to the families of those who have been killed at these crossings;
- (b) the details of the total number of railway under bridges and railway over bridges constructed since 2015 till date to do away with unmanned level crossings, year and State-wise;
- (c) the details of the total expenditure incurred on elimination of unmanned level crossings; and
- (d) the scheme formulated by the Ministry to eliminate all the unmanned level crossings within the stipulated time period?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI ASHWINI VAISHNAW)

(a) to (d): All Unmanned level crossings (UMLCs) on running lines of Broad Gauge (BG) network of Indian Railway have been eliminated by 31.01.2019. Since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019, no death case has been reported on UMLCs over Indian Railways.

Total 8,583 Nos. Road under Bridges (RUBs) & 1599 Road over Bridge (ROBs) have been constructed since 2015-16 (up to Oct'

2023) over Indian Railway which includes construction of RUBs/ROBs in lieu of Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs).

₹36,652 Crores have been spent for Road Safety Works (ROB/RUB & Level Crossings) including amount spent for elimination of UMLCs over Indian Railway since 2015-16 (Up to Oct'2023).
