- The Government of India has several initiatives to educate students/people at large i.e Mobile Science Lab, Mobile Science Jigyasa, Exhibition. STEMM Bike. Science Communication. Popularisation and Extension (SCoPE) program etc. These initiatives are reaching out to more than 2 million students/people across the country annually, educating them on new and emerging areas like Energy, Health, Artificial Intelligence, Climate Change, Water Conservation, Disaster Mitigation and Agro-technologies, apart from demonstrating experimental hands on activities in STEM education. As these programs are fulfilling the objectives of 'Science Express' to inculcate scientific temperament among masses, the Government of India currently does not have any plan to introduce more 'Science Express' trains.
