- (a) whether the Government is charging fares from passengers in Vande Bharat trains at a rate which is even more than 1.5 times the fares being charged in the Shatabdi Express trains and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has renamed the Shatabdi Express trains and are running these as Vande Bharat trains and if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government is running the Rajdhani Express trains by renaming it as Tejas and is charging more fare from the passengers; and
- (d) if so, details thereof?

- (a) & (b): No, Sir. Vande Bharat Express is a different type of train from Shatabdi Express. It is a new technology and has improved facilities like faster acceleration and semi high speed, better ride comfort, automatic plug doors etc.
- (c) & (d): No, Sir. Tejas Rajdhani Express is a different type of train from Rajdhani Express. It has improved facilities like electro-pneumatic assisted brakes, automatic entrance plug type door, re-designated eleather upholstery in seats, passenger information system and digital destination board, fire and smoke detection system, provision of CCTVs cameras etc.
