- (a) the reasons for delay in the construction of the Vijayawada bypass road in the NTR district;
- (b) the details and status of approved and proposed bypass roads in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the details and status of upcoming road projects in Narasaraopet Constituency;
- (d) whether the Government is actively taking measures to address the delayed projects; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) The work of six laning of the Vijaywada-Gundugolanu section of NH-16 having an aggregate length of 104 km was taken up by MoRTH in four packages. The Package-I&II are already completed and Package-III & IV involving the construction of Vijaywada bypass have been delayed due to various reasons such as Covid-19, incessant rain, delay in shifting of obstructing utilities and various court cases pertaining to land acquisition etc.

(b) Highway projects generally include provisions of bypasses to avoid city/town/habitations/built-up areas etc. The details of stand-alone bypass projects in the state of Andhra Pradesh is attached at Annex.

(c) Development of National Highways is a continuous process and projects for the development of National Highways are taken up based on fulfillment of criteria, inter se priority and availability of resources.

(d) & (e) Yes, sir. Regular review meetings and site inspections are conducted to resolve the execution related issues and Contractors/Concessionaire have been directed to mobilize additional resources for expediting the construction activities for timely completion of the Projects.
