Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress and achievements made under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan/Mission in the country during the last ten years;
- (b) whether any award has been presented to Hon'ble Prime Minister in connection with the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan/Mission;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has any details of the achievements made in Khandwa Parliamentary Constituency under the said mission and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) [SBM(G)] was launched on 2nd October, 2014 with the aim to achieve Open Defecation Free (ODF) status in rural areas by 2nd October, 2019 by providing access to toilets to all rural households. Under SBM(G), sanitation coverage increased from 39% in 2014 to 100% in 2019 with over 10 crore Individual household Latrines (IHHLs) constructed under Phase-I of SBM(G) and all the villages of the country declared themselves ODF by 2nd October, 2019.

Having achieved the ODF status, Phase-II of SBM (G) has been launched with effect from 1st April, 2020, with the focus on ODF sustainability and Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) in villages i.e. to convert the villages from ODF to ODF Plus by 2024-25. ODF Plus progress is captured in three categories viz. Aspiring and Rising (intermediate categories) and Model (final category). As per the data reported by the States/UTs on online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of SBM(G), out of **5,91,531** villages in the country, **5,01,513** villages have declared themselves Open Defecation Free (ODF) Plus (**3,17,427** Aspiring, **63,075** Rising and **1,21,011** Model) and **2,68,112** villages have been covered with Solid Waste Management (SWM) and **4,30,910** villages have been covered with Liquid Waste Management (LWM) in the Country as on **11-12-2023**.

(b) & (c) Hon'ble Prime Minister was conferred the 'Global Goalkeeper' Award by Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation for Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, on 24 September 2019. The award ceremony took place on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) session in New York.

(d) District-wise number of Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) and Community Sanitary Complexes (CSCs) constructed in Khandwa Parliamentary Constituency of Madhya Pradesh under SBM(G) are as under:
