(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Presently, 86 airports across the country are using green energy out of which the share of green energy in the airport's total energy consumption is 100% for 66 airports.

The extant policy enables domestic manufacturing of aircraft. The Government has been encouraging the manufacturing of aircraft, including regional transport aircraft and associated equipment by public and private enterprises in India.
