Naya Savera Scheme

1966. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) the salient features of the Naya Savera Scheme and the budgetary allocations made for the scheme during the last five years;
- b) the details of the work done under the said scheme in Jharkhand; and
- c) the details of the major achievements of the scheme pan-India and in Jharkhand?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a): The Ministry of Minority Affairs launched 'Naya Savera' scheme ('Free Coaching and Allied' scheme) in 2007 to assist students/candidates belonging to the six notified minority communities namely Sikh, Jain, Muslim, Christian, Buddhist and Parsi by way of special coaching for qualifying examinations for admission in technical/professional courses and competitive examination for recruitment to Group 'A', 'B', & 'C' services and other equivalent posts under the Central and State Governments including public sector undertakings, banks and railways. The budgetary allocations for the scheme during the last five years is as below:
