Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to increase thenumber of CNG stations across the country in view of the increasing number of CNG powered vehicles and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of CNG stations sanctioned inUttar Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (c) whether there is any plan to set up CNGstations in all the districts of Uttar Pradesh and if so, the details thereof?

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

- (a) Establishment of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) stations is part of the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) Network and the same is being carried out by the entities authorised by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) as per their Minimum Work Programme (MWP). After completion of 11A CGD bidding round, PNGRB has authorized 300 Geographical Areas (GAs) covering about 98% of the population and 88% of total geographical area of the country spread over around 630 districts in 28 states/UTs for the development of CGD network with MWP target of establishing 17,751 CNG stations across the country by 2032.
- (b) to (c) PNGRB has authorised 43 Geographical Areas (GAs) (including 1 GA spread over Madhya Pradesh&Uttar Pradesh, 1 GA spread over Uttarakhand& Uttar Pradesh, 1 GA spread over Bihar & Uttar Pradesh and 1 GA spread over Rajasthan & Uttar Pradesh) covering all the districts in state of Uttar Pradesh and the authorised CGD entities are required to establish 1649 CNG stations in the state of Uttar Pradesh by 2030. GA-wise details of MWP target for establishing CNG stations in the state of Uttar Pradesh are at Annexure.
