SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES UNDER PMKVY

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the need to set up skill development centres in various States to give training and to make persons self oriented for their livelihood and to tap their talent;
- (b) if so, the steps being taken during the last ten years in the country, year-wise;
- (c) the sectors in which training was provided to the candidates;
- (d) the steps taken/being taken to update them with the present technology and the funds spent/sanctioned for this purpose, year-wise; and
- (e) the corrective steps being taken to provide skill development particularly to women?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Under the Govt of India Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) provides skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling to all young Indians through a comprehensive network of Centres / Institutes across the country under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Scheme of Support to Jan Shikshan Sanstans (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

As a result of all these efforts, 34,468 PMKVY Training Centres (including Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs)), 309 Jan Shikshan Sanstans (JSS), 15,016 ITIs and 42,453 NAPS establishments situated in various states of the country have been involved in imparting skill training.

Since 2015, these centres/establishments have imparted training/orientation/On-the-job training (OJT) to around 2.91 Crore candidates under various courses. Year wise training data of the candidates trained/oriented from 2015-16 onwards is placed at **Annexure I**.

(c) Under PMKVY & JSS, Short Term Training have been provided to the candidates in various job roles of 36 sectors. For long term training, CTS through ITIs are being offered in 26 sectors. Apprenticeship Training in designated and optional trades under NAPS is provided across 40 sectors. Details of these Sectors may be seen at **Annexure II-A, II-B and II-C**.

(d) Ministry does not sanction funds for the up-gradation of the skill development centres under PMKVY. Ministry reimburses per candidate training cost to training partners based on the Common norms for different category of courses. However, training centres are updated/upgraded as per the requirement of the Job Roles and accreditation and affiliation norms of the scheme.

(e) In order to increase the participation of women candidates under PMKVY, conveyance cost, boarding and lodging facilities, accidental insurance with one year of coverage and post certification tracking allowance are being provided. Under PMKVY (from 2015 to 31.10.2023), 61 lakh female candidates have been trained.
