VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRES IN ASSAM

Will the Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship be pleased to state :

- (a) the number of centres engaged for providing vocational and professional training to the youths in the country including in the state of Assam, State-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the outcome of these centres and number of beneficiaries during the last five years, state-wise; and
- (c) the fund allocated and utilized for the purpose during the said period?

(a) Sir, Under the Govt of India Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) provides skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling to all young Indians through a comprehensive network of Centres / Institutes across the country under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Scheme of Support to Jan Shikshan Santhans (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), and Craftsmen Training Schemes (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

At present, there are 15,016 ITIs established in the country, out of which 3,289 ITIs are Government ITIs and 11,727 ITIs are Private ITIs. Under this scheme, skill training is imparted in 152 National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned courses (trades). These courses are designed to provide basic and and knowledge in that trade, so as to prepare the trainees for wage employment and/ or self-employment. The course curriculum is updated regularly to incorporate the latest technological equipment and industry requirements for future job roles.

Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) implemented through network of National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) and Institute of Training of Trainers (IToTs) across the country. In this scheme, comprehensive training is provided in both hands-on skills and training methodology to the instructor trainees to make them conversant with techniques of transferring hands-on skills and train skilled manpower for the industry. At present there are 33 National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) (19 NSTI (W) & 14 NSTI (G) and 121 Institute of Training of Trainers (IToTs) running across the country.

Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) is a Scheme under MSDE implemented through the agencies, to impart skill training to non-literates, neo-literates, persons with rudimentary level of education, and school dropouts up to 12th class in the age group of 15-45 years in rural areas and urban slums. At present, there are 288 JSSs functional across the country.

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is the flagship scheme of the MSDE with an objective to enable Indian youth to take up industry-relevant skill training that will help them in securing a better livelihood. PMKVY provides Short Term Training programs (STT) and also Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) in industry relevant trades. Under PMKVY, at present there are 2295 STT centres and 345 Special Training centres.

Apprenticeship Training Scheme (ATS) is also implemented by MSDE. Under ATS, candidate is engaged as an apprentice by an industries and gains classroom learning for a short period followed by hands-on training. Further MSDE has launched National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme, with an aim to promote apprenticeship training in the country by providing stipend support to the apprentices. At present, 50,005 industries are registered under ATS.

State wise list of vocational training centres functioning under above mentioned schemes is attached at *Annexure -1*. District wise list of vocational training centres functioning under above mentioned schemes for Assam State is attached at *Annexure – 2*.

(b) These centres have strengthened skill ecosystem of the country by providing skilling opportunities for the Indian youth. In the last five years, 1,98,92,158 candidates have been trained under above mentioned schemes. State wise enrollment under above mentioned scheme in ITIs, NSTIs and IToTs, PMKVY, and JSS for last five years is attached at *Annexure -3*.

(c) For State of Assam, MSDE has released Rs 227.83, 12.1 and 23.49 crores under PMKVY, JSS and NAPS respectively in last five years, i.e., FY 2018-19 to FY 2022-23.
