(a) to (d) : Government of India launched the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. In the State of Rajasthan, 4 cities i.e., Ajmer, Jaipur, Kota and Udaipur have been selected for development as Smart Cities. Details of progress in Smart Cities of Rajasthan is given below :
