2062. SHRIMATI SANDHYA RAY: DR. UMESH G. JADHAV:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the initiatives taken or programmes designed to cater to the specific requirements of senior citizens from minority groups in Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) the details of Schemes being implemented for Minorities in Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka and expenses incurred on these schemes, year and district-wise;
- (c) the level of effectiveness observed in these efforts; and
- (d) the number of beneficiaries in each schemes in Karnataka and Madhya Pradesh, district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) No such Scheme/Programme catering to the specific requirements of senior citizens of minority groups in Madhya Pradesh is under implementation by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.
- (b) to (d) The details of Schemes being implemented for Minorities in Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka and expenses incurred on these schemes, year and district-wise, are as under:
- 1. Educational Empowerment Schemes
 - i. Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme
 - ii. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme
 - iii. Merit-cum-Mean based Scholarship Scheme

These are Central Sector Schemes wherein, funds are directly transferred to the account of beneficiary. The details of number of students benefitted so far by the said schemes, State-wise including the state of Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka are available in the website of the Ministry i.e https://www.minorityaffairs.gov.in/. District-wise details of beneficiaries are not maintained in the scheme.

2. Employment and Economic Empowerment Schemes

i) 'Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS)' has subsumed Seekho aur Kamao (SAK), Nai Manzil, USTTAD and Nai Roshni, schemes of the Ministry. District-wise details of beneficiaries are not maintained in the scheme.
