#### VICTIM COMPENSATION SCHEME UNDER NIRBHAYA FUND

#### 2075. SHRI GNANATHIRAVIAM S.:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all the States/ Union Territories have notified victim compensation scheme under Nirbhaya Fund;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor indicating the names of such States/ Union Territories;
- (c) the quantum of funds released from this fund, State-wise since its inception; and
- (d) whether there is a separate compensation for victims that are physically/ mentally challenged?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b): In order to support and supplement the Victim Compensation Schemes of State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations, the Ministry of Home Affairs had released Rs. 200 crore as a one-time grant to the States/ UTs under the Central Victim Compensation Fund (CVCF) from Nirbhaya Fund, to enable compensation to victims of various crimes especially sexual offences including rape, acid attacks, crime against children, human trafficking etc. The corpus of Rs. 200 Crore was distributed among the States/ UTs in the year 2016-17 with the direction to achieve the above-mentioned objectives.
- (c) & (d): The details of State/ UT-wise fund released is at **Annexure**. The compensation for physically/ mentally challenged victims is included in the CVCF.
