Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is strengthening and upgrading the Anganwadi Centres for improved nutrition delivery and Early Childhood Care and Education, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the differences/changes between conventional Anganwadis and new Saksham Anganwadis indicating the number of Saksham Anganwadis in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Odisha;
- (c) the details of proposals received by the Government to open such Anganwadis in different districts of said States along with the plan formulated therefor, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has achieved success in the objectives of Saksham Anganwadi and POSHAN 2.0 campaign in these States, if so, the details and outcome thereof and if not, the reasons therefor:
- (e) the funds released and utilised to achieve the objectives of Saksham Anganwadi and POSHAN 2.0 campaign during the last three years, State and year-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) This Ministry has taken several measures under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0, for strengthening and upgrading the Anganwadi Centres for improving nutrition delivery and Early Childhood Care and Education. The details are as follows:

- 1. The cost norms for construction of Anganwadi Centres in convergence with MGNREGS have been revised from Rs. 7 lakh per AWC to Rs. 12 Lakh per AWC.
- 2. The unit cost approved for construction of toilet has been raised from Rs.12,000/- to Rs. 36000/- per AWC and for drinking water provisioning the approved cost has been raised from Rs.10,000/- to Rs. 17000/- per AWC to be shared by Centre and States/UTs as per the cost sharing ratio.
- 3. Directions have been issued to States/UTs to co-locate Anganwadi Centres, which are running on rent without sufficient infrastructure, at the nearby Primary Schools, where space is available.
- 4. During the 15th Finance Commission cycle, 2 lakh Anganwadi Centres @ 40,000 AWCs per year shall be upgraded as Saksham Anganwadis for improved nutrition delivery and for early childhood care and development
- 5. Keeping in view the importance of nutrition and Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) services delivery, it has been decided to upgrade all Mini-Anganwadi Centres to a full-fledged Anganwadi Centres with one Anganwadi Worker and one Anganwadi Helper.
- (b) & (c) Saksham Anganwadis are proposed to be provided with better infrastructure than the conventional Anganwadi Centres including internet/Wi-Fi connectivity, LED screens, water purifier/installation of RO Machine and equipped with smart learning and audio-visual aids and child-friendly learning equipment for ECCE. In this regard, the number of AWCs approved for upgradation to Saksham AWCs in the States of Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Odisha is at **Annexure-A**.
- (d) As per the report of NFHS-5 (2019-21), the nutrition indicators for children under 5 years of age across the country have shown an improving trend as compared with NFHS-4 (2015-16). Wasting percentage has declined from 21% (NFHS-4) to 19.3 % (NFHS-5), Percentage of under-weight children has reduced from 35.7% (NFHS-4) to 32.1% (NFHS-5) and stunting indicator has shown a decline from 38.4% (NFHS-4) to 35.5% (NFHS-5).

Moreover, as per the data of Poshan Tracker for the month of November 2023, around 7.44 crore children under 6 years were measured out of whom 37.51% were found severely/moderately stunted and 17.43% were found severely/moderately underweight. The prevalence of wasting as per Poshan Tracker is at 6 % which is much below NFHS 5 levels of 19.3%.

(e) The components of Supplementary Nutrition under Anganwadi Services, Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG) and Poshan Abhiyaan have been aligned under Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 as an integrated nutrition support programme from the FY 2021-22. The details of the fund released and utilized under the Mission Saksham Anganwadi and POSHAN 2.0 is tabulated at **Annexure-B**.
