- a) the details of the programmes being implemented for spreading awareness regarding AYUSH system of medicine in the country, State/UT-wise; and
- b) the details of the funds allocated and utilized for such programmes during the last three years and current financial year?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

a) The Ministry of Ayush implements the Central Sector Scheme for Promotion of Information Education and Communication (IEC) in Ayush to create awareness regarding Ayush System of Medicine. This aims to reach out to all sections of the population across the country. This scheme provides assistance for organizing National/ State Arogya Fairs, Yoga Fests/ Utsavs, Ayurveda Parvs, etc. The Ministry also undertakes Multi-Media, Print Media Campaigns for creating awareness about Ayush System. The details of programs organized by the Ministry to promote Ayush System of Medicine under the Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Scheme during the last three years and current year are at **Annexure-I**.

Awareness regarding the Ayush System of Medicine is also being spread through various IEC related activities under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Ministry of Ayush namely National Ayush Mission (NAM) in the country.
