- (c) the steps taken by the Government to make use of waterways and integrate these to the economic development of the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) & (b) Water transport being economical as well as eco-friendly mode of transport, Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, under Sagarmala programme, has undertaken Ro-Ro/ Ro-Pax projects across several routes. The details of completed and ongoing infrastructure projects for Ro-Ro & Ro-Pax ferry under Sagarmala programme are annexed.
- (c) Based on the outcome of techno economic feasibility and Detailed Project Reports prepared for National Waterways (NWs), NWs found to be viable for cargo and passenger movement andtourism purpose are being developed for integrating them with the coastal routes which will enhance the economic development of the country.
