Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state :

- (a) whether the Government has earmarked any funds for financial support to the Centre of Excellence under the Ayurswasthya Yojana in the country, State/ UT-wise;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the funds sanctioned and utilized under the Centre of Excellence component since the inception of the scheme;
- (d) whether the Government has received proposals from eligible individual organizations/ institutes in Haryana, particularly Sirsa Parliamentary Constituency under the Centre of Excellence component of the scheme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) Central Sector Scheme, of AYURSWASTHYA Yojana under Ministry of Ayush has its two components viz (i) AYUSH and Public Health (PHI) (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE).

The government has earmarked funds to the tune of Rs.180.00 Crores for financial support to the Centre of Excellence under the Ayurswasthya Yojana in the country. Being Central Sector Scheme, funds are not allocated State/UT wise. Under the Scheme, funds is supported to the eligible institutions across the country.

(c), (d) & (e) The Details of the funds released under Center for Excellence component of AYURSWASTHYA Yojana since its inception till date (as on 11.12.2023) to the organizations are placed at **Annexure – I**.

The government has not received proposals till date (11.12.2023) from eligible individual organizations/institutes in Haryana, particularly Sirsa Parliamentary Constituency under the Centre of Excellence component of the scheme.
