Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYSbe pleased to state: पत्तन,पोतपरिवहनऔरजलमार्गमंत्री

- (a) the details of national waterways on which freight transportation is operational, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan;
- (b) whether the Government provide any financial incentives and benefits to encourage people to use waterways as a medium of freight transportation;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to develop four national waterways from the State of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan;
- (e) whether the Government has released funds for the development of four national waterways in the State of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan;
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (g) whether the freight transportation activities are operational on any of the four national waterways in the States of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan; and
- (h) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) The details of the National Waterways on which freight transportation is operational, State wise including Uttar Pradesh is attached as **Annexure-1**. There is no waterway found viable for shipping and navigation in Rajasthan as per the feasibility study completed.

- (b)& (c)Yes, Sir. Ministry of Port Shipping and Waterways has waived off the waterway usage charges at a rate of Rs 0.02 per Gross Registered Tonnage (GRT) per kilometer for plying of Inland cargo vessels and Rs. 0.05 per gross registered tonnage (GRT) per kilometer for plying of Cruise vessels on national waterways to promote inland waterways as a supplementary, eco-friendly and cheaper mode of transport.
- (d), (e) & (f) Out of 111 National Waterways (NWs) declared vide National Waterways Act, 2016, 11 NWs are in the State of Uttar Pradesh and 3 NWs in Rajasthan (including interstate NWs)as detailed at **Annexure-2**. Feasibility Studies/Detailed Project Reports have been completed of the NWs. As per the findings of the Study Reports, no NW of Rajasthan has been found viable for shipping and navigation.2 NWs of Uttar Pradesh namely the Ganga (NW-1) and the Ghagra (NW-40) taken up for development for shipping and navigation. Development of a floating jetty on the stretch of Vrindavan-Mathura-Gokul (24 km) of River Yamuna (NW-110) has been taken up and details of funds utililzed is given at **Annexure-3**.
- (g) & (h)National Waterway-1 (NW-1) is operational for freight transportation in the State of Uttar Pradesh. Freight transportation activities are not operational on any of the three NWs of Rajasthan.
