- (a)the number of Kendriya Bal Shramik Vidyalayas opened across the country since the introduction of National Child Labour Project till date, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (b)the details of funds allocated and utilised as well as the achievements made under the said project, State-wise and yearwise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Labour & Employment had been implementing National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme for rescue & rehabilitation of child labourers under which the children in the age group of 9-14 years are rescued from work, enrolled in the NCLP Special Training Centres (STCs) and are provided with bridge education etc. before being mainstreamed into formal education system.

So far, NCLP scheme has been sanctioned in 324 no. of districts in 21 States and about 1.43 million working children have been mainstreamed to regular education system through NCLP scheme since the inception of the scheme. The NCLP scheme has been subsumed with Samagara Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) Scheme with effect from 01.04.2021.
