SKILL DEVELOPMENT IN MADHYA PRADESH

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and number of trainees benefitted in Madhya Pradesh under Skill Development Scheme including Khargone Parliamentary Constituency
- (b) the details of the new training centres to be established in tribal areas;
- (c) the details of the proposed new scheme related to skill development yojana in aspirational districts; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to set up such centres in hilly areas and rural areas?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM), the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres/institutes under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Sikhshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) to all the sections of the society across the country. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready & industry ready skills. Under these schemes, Training Centres are set up by private/public organizations on need based to impart the training across the country including hilly and rural areas.

Number of Trained candidates under schemes of MSDE in State of Madhya Pradesh including Khargone and Barwani Districts, is as follows:

Under MSDE various schemes viz. PMKVY, NAPS, CTS and JSS are being implemented across pan India including aspirational districts, with special focus on these districts. Further, a financial assistance of Rs. 10 lakh per Aspirational district was provided under Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP) Project of MSDE.
