(a) to (b): The Government is implementing various scholarship schemes for providing financial assistance to all categories of students includingScheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST). Further, as per information provided by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), the MoTA provides post matric scholarship to eligible Scheduled Tribe students for pursuing vocational courses like ITI and 3-year Diploma courses in Polytechnic institutes. Further, under the Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan (PM-USP) Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh of the Ministry of Education, scholarship is provided to the students including SC and ST, having domicile of UT of J&K and Ladakh and pursuing Graduation after completion of 12<sup>th</sup> class or Diploma in Engineering from Polytechnic Institutes recognized by Directorate of Technical Education, J&K and Ladakh. Moreover, as per information provided by the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), in order to increase and encourage women participation in vocational skilling, the Directorate General of Training (DGT) has waived off tuition and exam fee for women candidates who undergo training under Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) / Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) in National Skill Training Institutes (NSTIs) from session 2023-24 onwards.
