- (a)whether the Government had performed Bhoomi Pujan (land worship) of ESIC's hospital at village Paina Bujurg under Shahjahanpur Parliamentary Constituency of Uttar Pradesh;
- (b)if so, the details of the expenditure likely to be incurred on the construction of the hospital along with the time limit fixed for its completion; and
- (c)whether the work is going on as per time schedule and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor along with the persons responsible for the delay?

(a) to (c): Government has laid the foundation stone on 24.12.2021 at Village Pana Buzurg, Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh for the construction of a 30 bedded (upgradable to 100 beds) hospital. Construction work has been assigned to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) at an estimated amount of Rs.92.48 crore. The Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has requested the state government for conversion of land use to start the construction.
