# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2537 ANSWERED ON 19/12/2023

#### **SUBSIDIES UNDER PMAY-G**

### **2537. SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH:**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the houses sanctioned under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) along with the funds disbursed and pending to release till date in the State of Rajasthan, districtwise;
- (b) the subsidy claims approved by the concerned authority under the Yojana for the individuals who have not been released by the National Housing Bank since one and half year to two years;
- (c) whether the Government is initiating any steps to inform the Nodal Agency of the States to immediately release the approved amount of subsidies under Yojana which were approved since long to the beneficiaries and not released in whole or partially thereby enforcing burden on the beneficiaries to pay the interest on the amount borrowed towards homeloan and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the details of the funds released to the nodal agencies of the States monitoring the Yojana for further release to the beneficiaries in the State of Rajasthan?

### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): To achieve "Housing for All" in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016. The target is to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March 2024. As on 13.12.2023, a target of 2.95 crore houses has been allocated to States/UTs, of which, more than 2.94 crore houses have been sanctioned to the

beneficiaries by the States/UTs and 2.51 crore houses have been completed. As on date 13.12.2023, the total fund released in the State of Rajasthan is Rs. 12,667.02 crore under PMAY-G since inception and the pending liability for FY 2023-24 is Rs. 40.47 crore. The State of Rajasthan has been requested to submit a complete proposal for release of funds. Further, as on 13.12.2023, the number of the houses targeted, sanctioned, completed and fund utilized in the State of Rajasthan District wise is attached as per Annxeure I. The Central Assistance under PMAY-G is released directly to the State/UT considering the State/UT as a unit.

(b) & (c): The National Housing Bank (NHB) has been identified by the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), as a Central Nodal Agency (CNA) for implementation of the Rural Housing Interest Subsidy Scheme (RHISS) in Rural Areas. The NHB is implementing the Scheme through eligible Primary Lending Institutions (PLIs), which have signed MOUs with NHB, as per the Scheme Guidelines issued by the MoRD. RHISS is applicable for home loans sanctioned and disbursed post 19-06-2017. The full details of the RHISS scheme are available in public domain on NHB's website, and can be accessed through the following link-

As per the data available on the RHISS portal of NHB as on 13-12-2023, 2790 claims of subsidy amount of Rs. 3.63 crore are pending with NHB at various stages. The oldest claim which was uploaded on 16-12-2022 on the RHISS portal is pending due to non-compliance of the PLIs viz.: receipt of additional information/ clarification/compliances/uploading of geo-referenced time and date stamped photographs and captured on AwaasSoft through AwaasApp in RHISS Mobile App and submitting Claim Application Form (CAF) after getting it signed and stamped by the authorized signatory on the RHISS portal.

(d): Further, NHB as a CNA had received Rs. 48.54 crore from Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) under the scheme RHISS during the financial year 2019-20 for implementing the scheme by providing the interest subsidy to 12,000 beneficiaries, out of which, NHB had released subsidy amount of Rs. 0.66 crore for approximately 210 beneficiary households under RHISS in the state of Rajasthan. There is an unspent balance of Rs. 27.44 crore available with NHB under RHISS as on 12.12.2023.
