Intensive Aquaculture of Ponds and Tanks

2636. DR. SANJEEV KUMAR SINGARI:

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** मत्स्य पालन, पशु पालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has promoted scheme for Intensive Aquaculture of Ponds and Tanks in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details of activities and funds dispersed under the scheme during the last three years' district-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government has taken any steps to promote and development of fisheries in the reservoirs of Andhra Pradesh;
- (e) if so, the details of activities and funds dispersed for the promotion of reservoir fisheries; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a): Yes Sir
- (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) has approved (i) 99 unit of bio-floc ponds at a cost of Rs.15.58 crore and (ii) 62 unit of Re-Circulatory Aquaculture System at a cost of Rs. 17.64 crore to Andhra Pradesh for intensive aquaculture. District wise activities allocated and fund released during last three years are given at Annexure-I.
- (c): Does not arise
- (d): Yes Sir.
- (e): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) has approved (i) (i) 300 unit of reservoir cages for fish culture at a cost of Rs.9.00 crore and (ii) stocking of fish fingerlings in 1,91,000 hectare of reservoirs at a cost of Rs.57.42 crore. Government of Andhra Pradesh has reported that fingerling stocked in 176400 hectare of reservoirs.
