**Brood Banks**

**2683. SHRI BALASHOWRY VALLABHANENI:**

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING** मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of brood banks, integrated development of reservoirs, hatcheries established in Andhra Pradesh (AP) under PM Matsya Sampada Yojana since 2020-21, district-wise;
- (b) the details of units supported for seaweed culture and supported integrated fish farming in Andhra Pradesh since implementation of PMMSY, year and district-wise; and
- (c) the details of funds sanctioned, approved, released and utilized in AP for the said purposes since implementation of PMMSY, district-wise?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING**

**(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

- (a): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India has approved 14 unit of hatcheries, one Brood Bank for Tilapia and 300 unit of reservoir cages under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) to Andhra Pradesh since 2020-21 based on the Demand of the State Government. Government of Andhra Pradesh reported that Tilapia brood bank established in Anantpur District, one hatchery established in Krishna District and 3 hatcheries established in Bapatla District.
- (b): Under PMMSY, 26000 units of rafts and 41200 units of monoline/tubenet approved to Government of Andhra Pradesh for sea weed culture. District-wise rafts and monoline/tubenet sanctioned for sea weed culture as reported by Government of Andhra Pradesh furnished at Annexure-I.
- (c): During last three years and current financial year, proposal of Government of Andhra Pradesh approved at a total cost of Rs.2332.38 crore under PMMSY and the Central share of Rs.341.11 crore released to Government of Andhra Pradesh for various activities including sea weed culture, brood bank and reservoir development. Out of Rs.341.11 crore released under PMMSY, Government of Andhra Pradesh reported utilization of Rs.215.46 crore. District-wise fund allocated and released for seaweed culture as reported by Government of Andhra Pradesh furnished at Annexure-I.
