SECURITY CONSULTANCY BY CISF

2722. DR. G. RANJITH REDDY:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) is doing security consultancy for public and private sector and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the details of amount that CISF is earning through security consultancy;**
- (c) the formula being followed for charging security consultancy by CISF;**
- (d) whether there are any plans to take up international security consultancy;**
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (f) whether any discussions have been held with other countries or international agencies and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) provides technical consultancy service to industrial establishments in public and private sector. CISF has generated a revenue of Rs. 16.07 crores from 228 establishments from consultancy services.

(c): Consultancy fee is calculated on the basis of expenditure incurred by the Government on the board of officers conducting the consultancy plus contingency charges @ 10%. Methodology of calculating consultancy fee takes into account the factors like number of employees, gross turnover figures in a financial year and geographical expanse of the industrial establishment.

(d) to (f): Plans to take up international security consultancy is not under consideration at present.
