- (a) whether the Government has started the Broadcast Infrastructure and Network Development (BIND) Scheme in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the objective of the Scheme and the time by when it was started;
- (c) whether agriculture related channels such as DD Kisan and DD
 Metro are being telecasted by Doordarshan centers in regional
 languages under the said Scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the details of information regarding popularity of these programmes, State-wise including Chhattisgarh?

(a) & (b): Yes Sir, The Government has approved continuation of the Central Sector Scheme "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development (BIND)" with an outlay of Rs. 2539.61 crore for the period 2021-26 under various components for modernization and upgradation of Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development of Prasar Bharati (Akashvani and Doordarshan).

(c) & (d): DD Kisan is a national channel dedicated for agriculture related content in Hindi. Further, 18 Doordarshan Regional Kendras are telecasting agriculture related content in their programme 'Krishi Darshan' in 11 regional languages. Doordarshan Kendra-wise including DDK Chhattisgarh and channel-wise details of viewership are at Annexure.
