Construction of Youth Hostels

283. DR. A. CHELLAKUMAR:  
SHRI BENNY BEHANAN:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total funds allocated and utilised for construction of Youth Hostels, year-wise;
- (b) the details of steps taken by the Government to guarantee quality standards, hygiene and infrastructure improvements in Youth Hostels;
- (c) the details of measures taken by the Government to facilitate a cooperative effort between the volunteers of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and Common Service Centres (CSCs) aimed at enhancing digital and financial literacy among rural populations under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Mission (PMGDISHA); and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to raise the remuneration for National Youth Volunteers from Rs.5000 and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) The details of funds allocated and utilized for construction of Youth Hostels for last two years and current year are given below:

(b) As per Youth Hostel Manual, Manager of Youth Hostel is responsible to maintain the Hostel building and fixtures, its equipment and stores in good working condition and to ensure a high standard of hygiene and cleanliness in the kitchen, dormitories, lawns, social areas and Hostel surroundings. A need based, one-time grant/financial assistance upto Rs.20 lakhs can be released for renovation/up-gradation of Youth Hostels, subject to viability of the proposal and availability of funds. Further with a view to ensure the quality of service delivery to the visitors, currently, 19 Youth Hostels are ISO 9001:2015 certified.

(c) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) is not engaged with Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Mission. However, in order to enhance financial literacy among rural population, NYKS, in collaboration with Ministry of Corporate Affairs, conducted 150 programmes in 2022-23 and imparted financial literacy among 12,377 youth.

(d) There is no such proposal under consideration.
