2873. DR. PON GAUTHAM SIGAMANI:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Sanchar Saathi portal has received an impressive response from those who lost their mobile devices since its nationwide launch:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Sanchar Saathi has blocked almost 11 lakh mobiles, tracked several mobiles and handed over mobile devices to the owners; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) to (d) Government is committed to ensure safety and security of telecommunication users. Government has launched Sanchar Saathi portal (https://sancharsaathi.gov.in) which empowers citizens:
 - (i) to know the mobile connections issued in their name and report the mobile connections for disconnection which are either not required or not taken by them,
 - (ii) to report the stolen / lost mobile handset for blocking and tracing,
 - (iii) to check the genuineness of mobile handset,
 - (iv) to report the incoming international calls received with Indian telephone number as calling line identification,
 - (v) to check the details of licensed wireline Internet Service Providers.

Citizens can report lost or stolen mobile phone by using 'Block Your Lost or Stolen Phone' facility of Sanchar Saathi portal by filling a simple online form. The portal is connected to more than 15,000 police stations across the states / UTs and can also be used by police for blocking the lost or stolen device reported by the citizens at police stations.

The reported mobile phones are blocked automatically in the networks of all the telecom service providers and such phones cannot be misused in India. If anyone tries to use the blocked mobile phone, traceability information is generated and automatically made available to police station concerned and to the citizen. Once mobile phone is recovered by the police it may be unblocked on the portal for its normal use by the citizens. As on date the impact of 'Block Your Lost or Stolen Mobile' facility of Sanchar Saathi portal is as under:

Sanchar Saathi portal has become very popular in a short span of time and has been visited by 3.46 crore visitors as on date. Other notable achievements of Sanchar Saathi portal are as under:
