Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of passengers who have travelled on Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat service till date;

(b) the total distance that has been covered by Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat since its inception i.e. till November, 2023;

(c) whether it is true that post commencement of Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat, the train has helped citizens to reach tourist/religious places more conveniently along the route and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the number of people, district-wise who have been benefited from this Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat service?

(a) to (d): 22223/22224 Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat Express trains cover a distance of approximately 343 km each-way between Mumbai and Sainagar Shirdi six days a week. From the date of introduction of 22223/22224 Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus Mumbai-Sainagar Shirdi Vande Bharat trains on 11th/12th February 2023, till 30th November 2023, these trains provided comfortable journey between Mumbai and Sainagar Shirdi to approximately 4,52,108 passengers. District-wise details of passengers are not maintained.
