INCREASE IN FARE OF SLEEPER CLASS TICKETS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Indian Railways has reduced the number of Sleeper Class
- (SL) and general coaches and converted these into 2AC and 3AC coaches to increase revenue;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard, train-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons to increase the fare of Sleeper Class (SL) tickets?

(a) to (c) To cater to the needs of General Class passengers, the extant policy pertaining to the composition of Mail/Express services provide for 12 General & Sleeper non-AC (Air Conditioned) coaches and 08 AC-Coaches in a train of 22 coaches, thereby providing for greater accommodation for passengers using General & Sleeper non-AC coaches. Further, across Indian Railways, of the total number of coaches being utilized for running of trains, two-third are non-AC and one-third are AC.
