SCHEMES FOR MINORITIES IN ODISHA

3042. SHRI BASANTA KUMAR PANDA:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of number of schemes implemented by the Government for Minorities across the country during the last five years and the current year;
- (b) the details of number of beneficiaries in Odisha during the said period, district-wise;
- (c) the funds allocated to Odisha during the said period and the expenditure incurred by the said State Government; and
- (d) the details of the financial assistance provided to Minorities College/NGO/Trust during the said period?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c) The Government implements various schemes for the welfare and upliftment of every strata, including minorities, specially the economically weaker and lesser privileged sections of the society, through various schemes of the different Ministries. Ministry of Minority Affairs specifically implements various schemes across the country for socio-economic and educational empowerment of the six (6) centrally notified minority communities. The details of minority welfare schemes are as under:

(A) Educational Empowerment Schemes

- i. Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme
- ii. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme
- iii. Merit-cum-Mean based Scholarship Scheme

Details of the number of beneficiaries district wise in Odisha for the last five years at "Annexure-I" and the fund allocated to Odisha during the said period is at "Annexure-II".

(B) Employment and Economic Empowerment Schemes

i) 'Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS)' has subsumed Seekho aur Kamao (SAK), Nai Manzil, USTTAD and Nai Roshni, schemes of the Ministry. These schemes were implemented via Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) that were selected through a transparent RFP process. State-wise fund allocation was not made under these schemes.

Number of people trained under these schemes in the state of Odisha in the last five years is given as follows.

ii) National Minorities Development and Finance Corporation(NMDFC) provides concessional loans to minorities on refinance mode which supports them in their Economic empowerment and generation of livelihoods. Government supports the NMDFC in execution of this programme. In the State of Odisha, Orissa Backward Classes Finance & Development Cooperative Corporation (OBCFDCC) is the State Channelising Agency (SCA) of NMDFC. OBCFDCC has not drawn any funds from NMDFC during last five years and during the current year also, since OBCFDCC is implementing State Govt. schemes only. To expand coverage of NMDFC schemes, NMDFC has signed MOU with Canara Bank in F.Y. 2021-22 for implementing NMDFC schemes mainly in the States/UTs where SCAs are not functional.

District-wise detail of loan disbursed & number of beneficiaries financed by Canara Bank under NMDFC schemes in State of Odisha during last two financial years is enclosed as "Annexure-III".

(C) Infrastructure Development Schemes

Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) provide infrastructure for Socioeconomic development in Minority concentrated areas. The details of projects approved for Odisha during last Five years and current year are as under:
