Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized so far under the SCM in the State of Assam;
- (b) the details and the number of cities identified under the SCM in the said State;
- (c) the details of the target set and achievements made so far thereunder;
- (d) whether the Government is facing any difficulty in the completion/implementation of the said mission within the stipulated time in the said State; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the steps taken/being taken by the Government to resolve the issues?

(a) to (e): Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. In the State of Assam, Guwahati has been selected for development as a Smart City in Round-I in January, 2016. The details of funds released/ spent and progress of its projects is given below:-
