**SHARE OF MSMEs IN GDP**

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds utilized in Emergency Credit Line Guaranteed Scheme/Guaranteed Emergency Credit Line Scheme; and
- (b) the current share of MSMEs in total Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and employment, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

(a): Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) was launched in May, 2020 as part of Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan to support eligible Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and business enterprises in meeting their operational liabilities and restarting their business enterprises in the context of disruption caused by the COVID – 19 pandemic. ECLGS was operational till 31.03.2023. As reported by Department of Financial Service (DFS), under ECLGS total 1.19 crore guarantees amounting to Rs. 3.68 lakh crore were issued to businesses, including MSMEs.

(b): As per the latest information received from Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation, the share of MSME Gross Value Added (GVA) in all India Gross Domestic Product (GDP) during the year 2021-22 was around 29%.
